Loyola University Maryland is at the corner of W Cold Spring Lane and N Charles St in Baltimore.

Airport: BWI Thurgood Marshall Airport is a 30-40-minute ride via car.

MTA Bus LocalLink 51 line to the corner of W Cold Spring Lane and N Charles Street.

Rail: Baltimore Penn Station is a ~15-minute ride via car or a 20-30-minute ride via MTA Bus LocalLink 51

## WHERE TO CHECK-IN FOR DORMS

Check-In is in Avila Hall. See map. It is staffed on a regular day such as Wednesday from 8 am – 5 pm. If you will be arriving late or at any other time-such as a day or two early notify Guest Services (410) 617-5176 if no one is at the Avila Hall Desk when you arrive on campus. Our dorm suites are in Campion Hall along with ALPhA's BFY III participants and PIRA participants. ## WHERE TO PARK

Parking is behind Newman Towers. See map. Parking is free in non-reserved spaces in the west side resident student lots for all conference attendees. This lot is right beside Avila Hall. The Jenkins lot adjacent to the east side of Donnelly Science Center is a **pay** lot (\$4/hour) from 7 am – 9:30 pm, so for those driving in each day, we recommend the free parking at the dorms.
